## Group Descriptions

**Foundations!** RCS' Foundations group works on teaching the skills necessary to be able to learn in a group environment with other peers. Skills targeted in this group include successfully transitioning away from a caregiver and into a classroom, transitioning from activity to activity, generalizing skills, sharing toys and attention, requesting attention, independent play skills and social skills.

**Let's Play Together!** RCS' Let's Play Together social skills groups work on teaching developmentally appropriate play skills within a fun and engaging group setting using research-based ABA teaching procedures. Play skills targeted include independent play skills (with vocals), parallel play with peers, group games, and pretend play skills.

**Let's Be Friends!** RCS' Let's Be Friends social skills group focuses on targeting the social skills necessary to create and maintain positive social relationships with peers.

**Ready, Set, School!** RCS' Ready, Set, School social skills group works on teaching strategies to help students successfully manage the social and behavioral expectations of school. This is a great option for children getting ready to start school for the first time in the fall as well as those already attending school.
